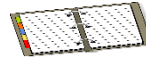
SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

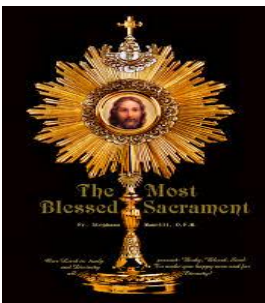

Good Shepherd Center History:

I would like to provide a little history about the Good Shepherd Center. It is an ecumenical outreach serving people living in Monroe County that are in need. After years of working out of various local church facilities, the Center acquired its first independent location in 2002 on College Street in Madisonville. Since then an Executive Director and a whole host of volunteers manage the operations of the Center.

By 2004 the Center moved to its present location at 501 Hwy 411 S, Madisonville. Over the years the original building has doubled in size and a walk-in freezer was added. A walk-in cooler will be completed in the next several months.

The operating funds mainly come from numerous participating churches, businesses, grants and people like you. St. Joseph the Worker has a long tradition of supporting the Good Shepherd Center. The collection that is taken up each Sunday at the end of Mass goes to support the work of the Center. The Center has only one major fundraising event a year. The plans for this year are still being finalized. But the date is set. **Please put Thursday, October 10 on your calendar.** Your attendance at this event will help ensure its success.
