

**Second Collection for Response to Hurricanes Florence and Michael and other Disasters. On Sat & Sun, November 3 & 4,**

the Diocese of Knoxville will take up a second collection for disaster relief for victims of Hurricanes Florence and Michael. Funds will be used in response to Hurricanes Florence and Michael as well as for any other natural disasters that occur this year. Funds will assist the ongoing efforts of Catholic Charities USA to provide humanitarian aid for the immediate help of those in need in the affected areas, as well as to the long-term efforts to restore communities after such widespread destruction. Funds will also go to support the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' efforts to assist with pastoral and reconstruction aid to the Church. Humanitarian funds for any future disasters impacting communities outside the US may be shared with Catholic Relief Services for their response efforts.
