**Please be generous today in supporting the Collection for World Mission Sunday.** By baptism, all Catholics are called to participate in the mission of the Church and to share their faith as missionaries of the Gospel. This collection supports the pastoral and evangelizing programs and needs of nearly 1200 mission dioceses in Africa, Asia, the Pacific Islands, and remote regions of Latin America. Funds are distributed in the Holy Father's name by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith—a Pontifical Mission Society. Pope Pius XI first instituted Mission Sunday with the first worldwide collection in 1927 to help emphasize our catholicity in sharing in our common responsibility for evangelizing the world.

**Please be generous on Oct 29 in supporting our Diocesan Deacon Formation Program.** Our Diocese is blessed with 73 permanent Deacons, serving 35 parishes, with another 29 men currently starting the formation process. Deacons are a bridge between the sanctuary and the world in which they live and work. Your donation helps with new deacon formation and the continuing education of ordained deacons in the diocese. This program costs about \$115,000 each year. Please be generous in your gift to help support the permanent Deacons of our Diocese.

During this week (Oct 21-28), the **Dedication Stone Pilgrimage** will be at our parish. We will host this representation of the Cathedral's much larger cornerstone as it makes its circuit of the diocese. The photo of the cornerstone being blessed by Pope Francis on October 14, 2015 will accompany this stone to each parish.
